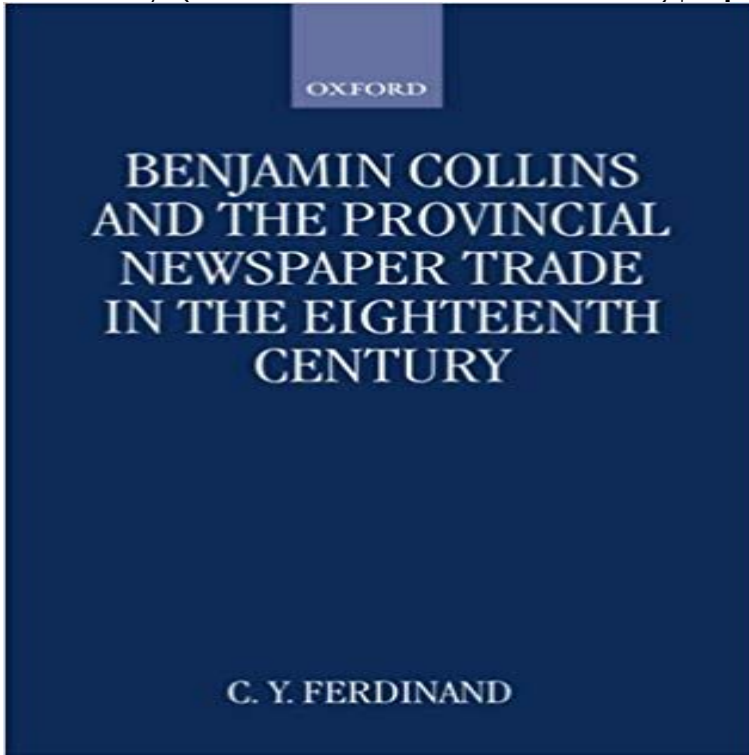


# Benjamin Collins and the Provincial Newspaper Trade in the Eighteenth Century (Oxford Historical Monographs)
