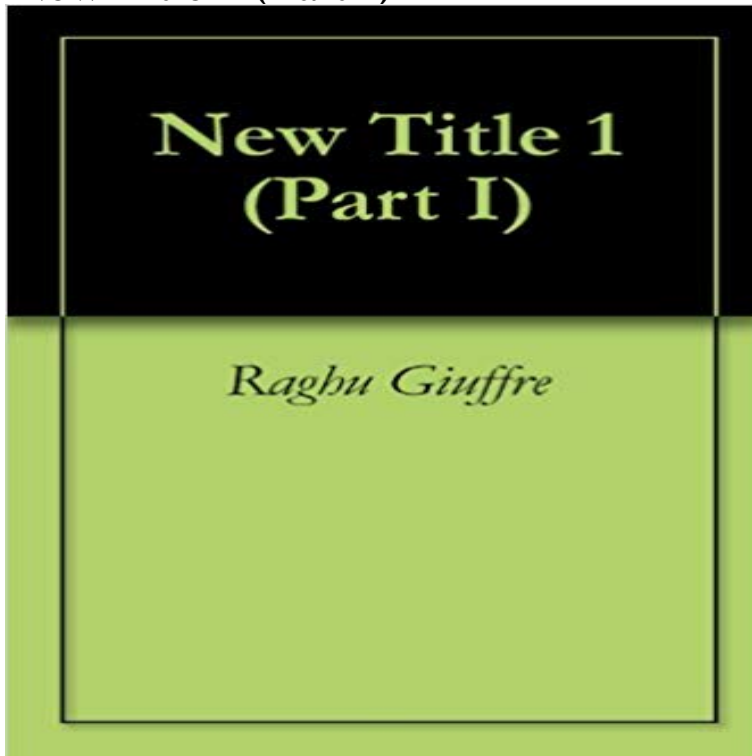


New Title 1 (Part I)
