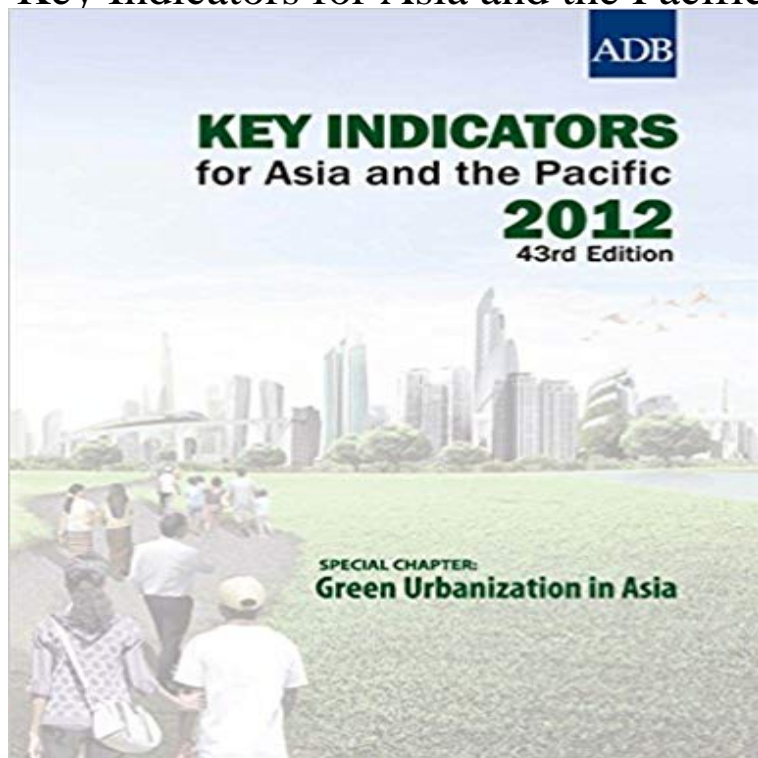


Key Indicators for Asia and the Pacific 2012
