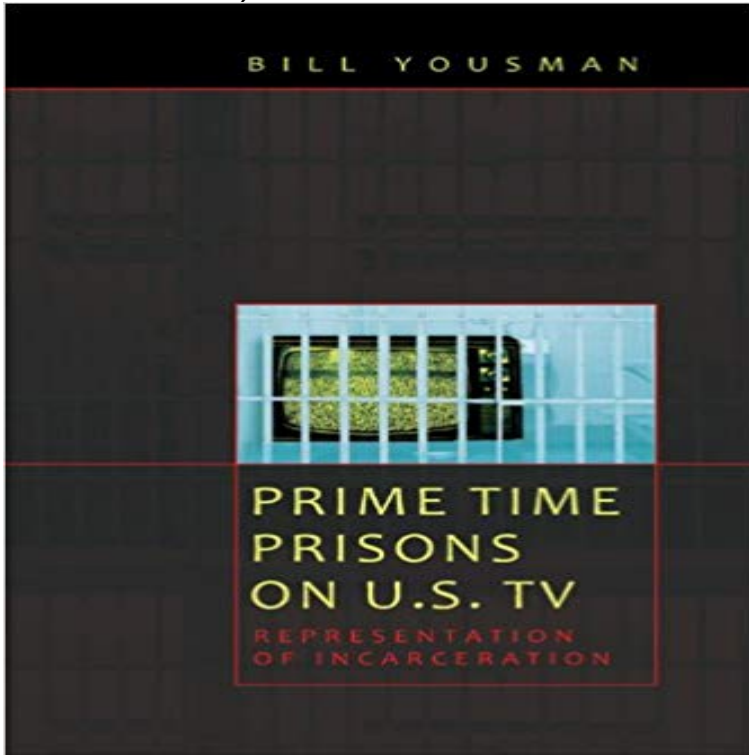


Prime Time Prisons on U.S. TV: Representation of Incarceration (Media and Culture)
