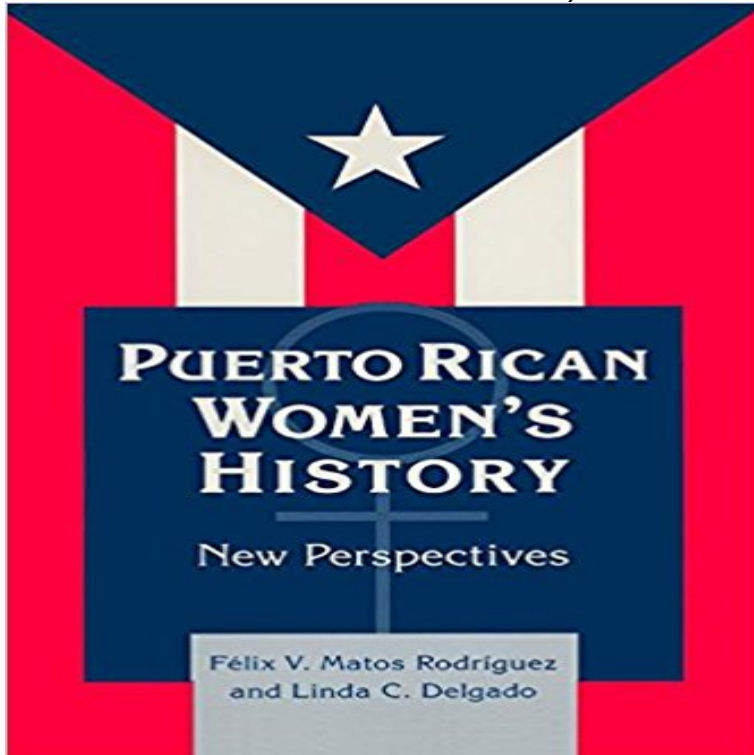


Puerto Rican Womens History: New Perspectives (Perspectives on Latin American and the Caribbean)
