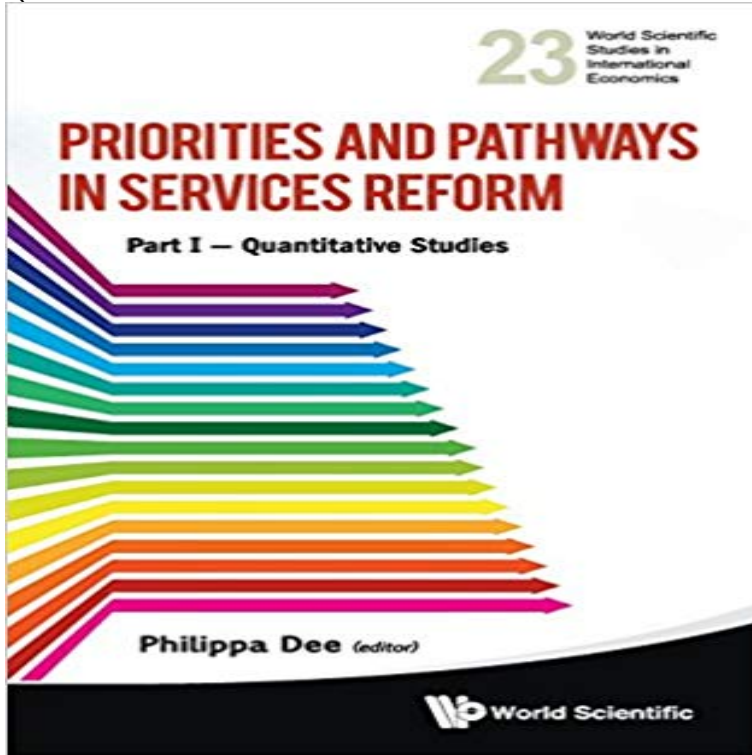


Priorities and Pathways in Services Reform: Part I - Quantitative Studies (World Scientific Studies in International Economics)

It uses advanced modeling techniques to project the sectoral, economy-wide and regional effects of services reforms, as well as highlight their adjustment costs. The empirical results offer fresh guidance to policy-makers, who need better information bases with which to prioritize services reforms and devise pathways to achieving them.
