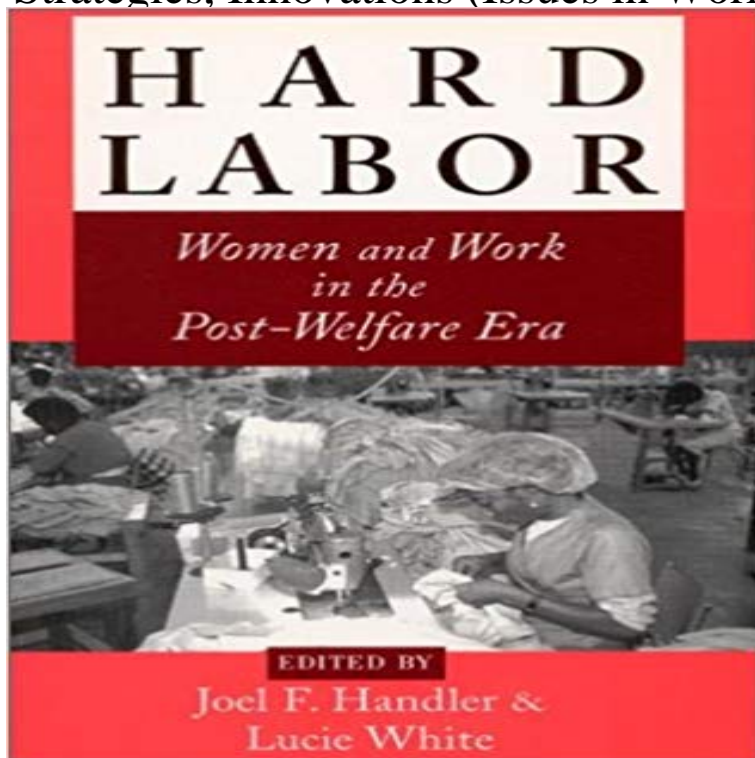


Getting Real About Work for Low-income Women: Challenges, Strategies, Innovations (Issues in Work and Human Resources)
