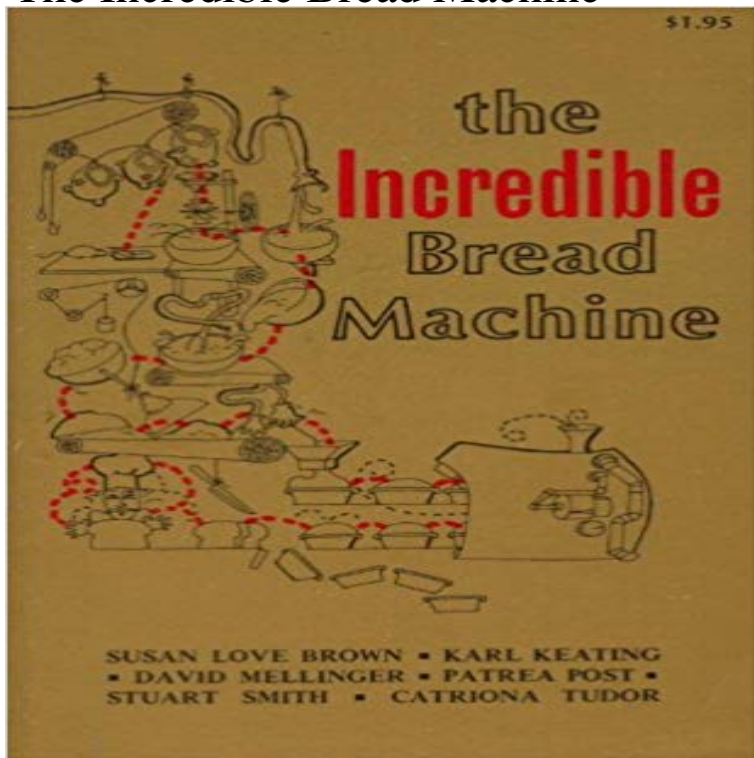


The Incredible Bread Machine
