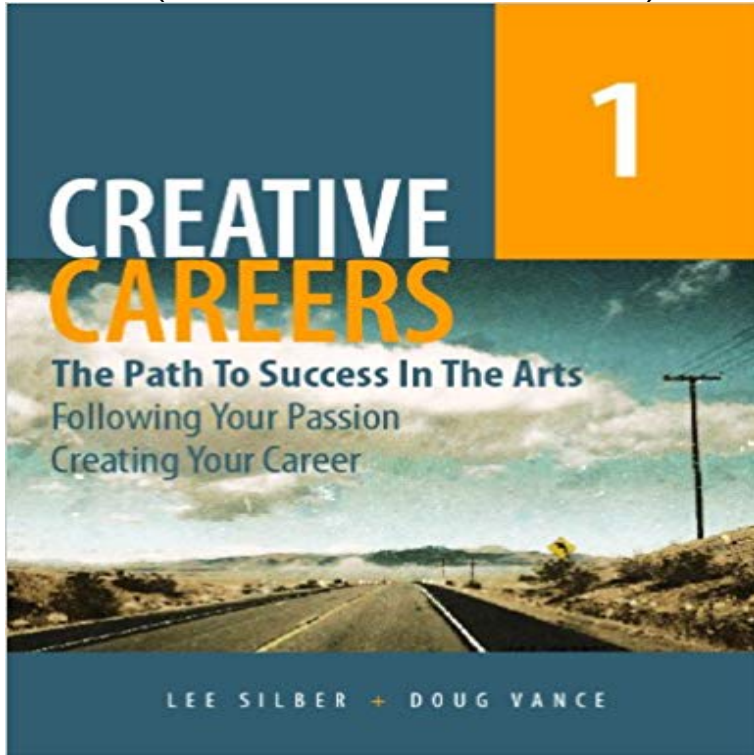


The Path to Success in the Arts: Following Your Passion, Creating Your Career (Creative Careers Book 1)
