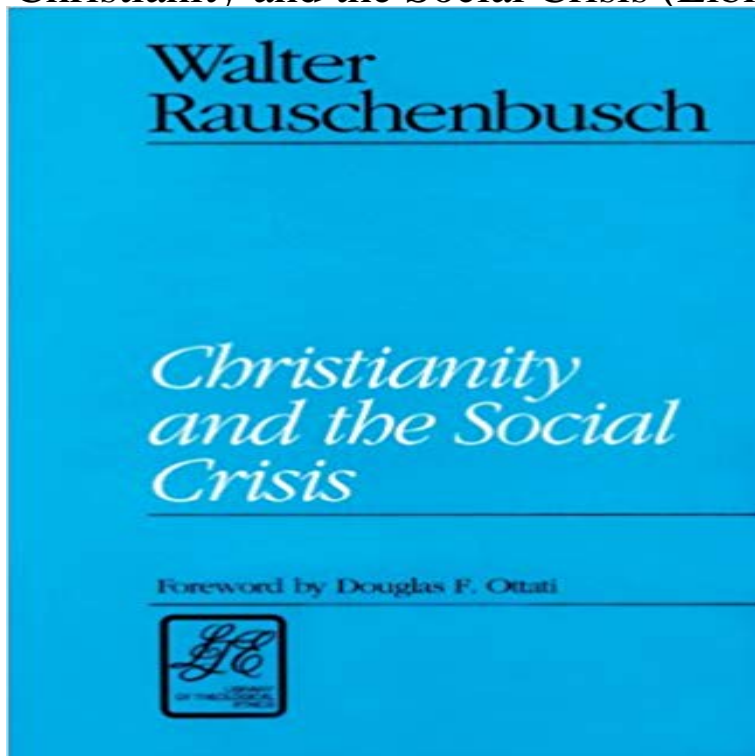


Christianity and the Social Crisis (Library of Theological Ethics)
