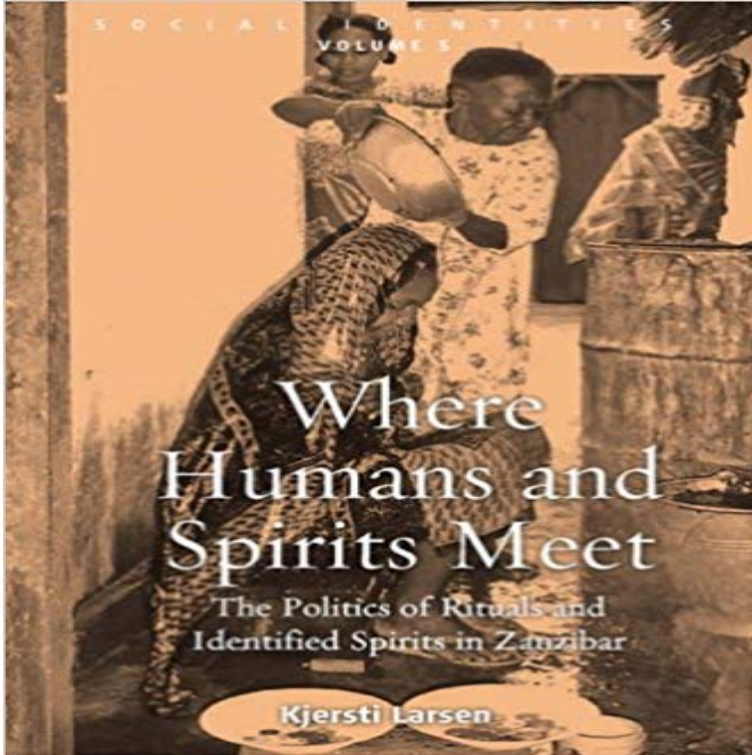


Where Humans and Spirits Meet: The Politics of Rituals and Identified Spirits in Zanzibar (Social Identities)
