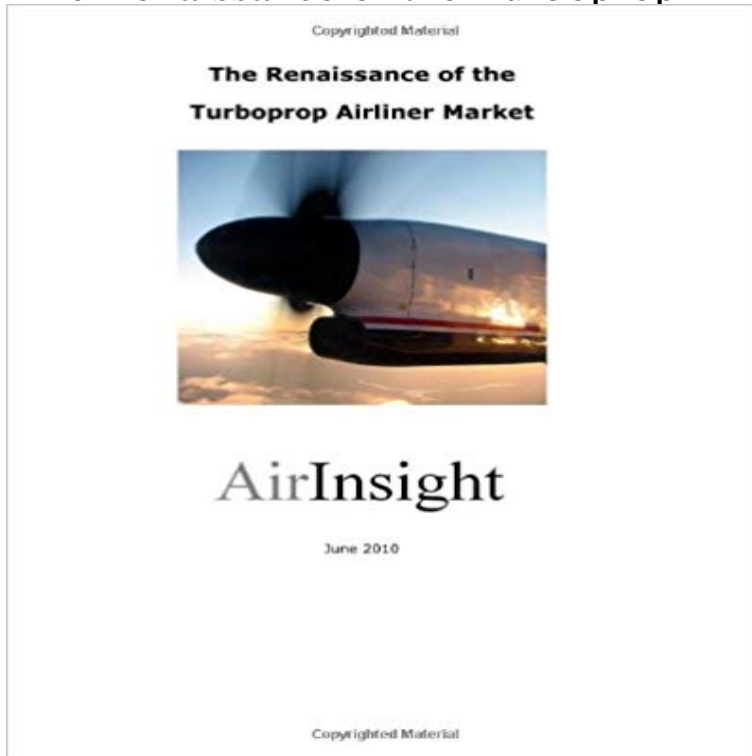


# The Renaissance of the Turboprop Airliner Market
